The Baddour Center opened its doors in 1978 and today is home to 170 men and women who live, work, worship and celebrate fellowship with one another on The Center's 120-acre campus in rural Senatobia, MS, located only 35 miles south of Memphis, TN. These individuals come to The Center from 25 states; 50 percent are from Mississippi and Tennessee, and range in age from 18 to 78 years. The ethnic groups represented are Caucasian, African-American and Asian-American. The socio-economic status of the residents' families covers a wide range, including high, medium and low-income families. Of the 170 residents, 19 percent receive scholarship assistance.
